

Eastman Walking Paths

#	Path	Location	Good For	Parking	Considerations
1	Fire Lanes/Trails in West Cove (part of Lake Trail)	Hugs lake shore and inlet at West Cove area	Walks Bikes** Strollers**	West Cove beach park area – .1 mile north of wooden bridge	Wide dirt path*
2	Nature Trails by former West Cove tennis courts	Cove Drive & Road Round Lake	Walks	Parking spots just beyond courts	Two trails – short 250 yd. loop & .5 mile loop – “bumpy” trails, but short, and near roads. Hiking shoes appropriate.
3	X-C Trail #6*** “Sewer line” trail	Trail from South Cove to West Cove beach	Walks Bikes** Strollers**	Alpine Vista old ski area parking	The trail is mostly a fairly easy, wide trail, but there is one short steep hill.
4	Brook Trail - X-C Trail ***	Parallel Clearwater Drive	Walks	South Cove Activity Center	Most of trail is easy; Recreation has a “treasure hunt” trail map for this section. However, steep front section.
5	Brook Trail - X-C Trail ***	Option – enter end of Troon Drive onto trail	Walks	End of Troon Dr. – “open” area. Limited parking.	Entering here avoids the steep section at Road Round Lake descent.
6	John’s Glen - X-C Trail ***	Starts at end of Clearwater Drive	Walks Bikes** Strollers**	Cul de sac at end of Clearwater Drive	.5 mile to “warming hut”; is relatively flat dirt road. Also, pond loops. Virtually no other buildings visible.
7	Logging Road	Near Deeryard tennis courts	Walks Bikes** Strollers**	Roadside or tennis court parking	A relatively quiet dirt road, with few houses.
8	Clearwater Drive	South Cove area & Road Round Lake	Walks Bikes** Strollers**	South Cove parking lot	A relatively quiet dirt road, with few houses.
9	Golf Course (X-C*** in winter) Paths Off Season	Start at Clubhouse Road	Walks Strollers**	The Center parking lot	Use paved pathways only. Restricted seasonal usage. No dogs allowed.

* Please consider season, weather conditions, etc. when using dirt trails, paths or roads. Conditions vary greatly depending on circumstances.

** Only certain type bikes or strollers are suitable for some of these areas. Check out by walking first to verify you have right equipment.

*** X-C (Cross Country) trails are not open to walking, etc. when X-C center is open.
